What's the application criteria?

How do I apply for Seaspan's InternSHIP program?

All career opportunities will be available on our careers site. Only applications submitted through this site will be accepted. Our application process includes completing an online application form and submitting your resume.

What if I don't see any intern positions posted?

If you don't see any available intern opportunities on our careers site, it is possible that all of our intern positions have been filled for the upcoming term. You can wait for the next round of internship openings, or submit your resume for general consideration using the link at the bottom of the careers site.

Can I apply for an internship if I live, study and/or work in a different province or country?

Yes, you can apply to an internship from any country where you currently live, study or work. However, you will need to have independent work authorization and be physically present in British Columbia, Canada for the duration of the InternSHIP program. For internship positions, we are unable to support relocation, travel, or work permit costs.

Is the internship virtual or office-based?

Seaspan will continue to ensure a safe working environment for Employees and maintain our COVID-19 safety plan per provincial requirements and guidance. Each internship will be reviewed, and office-based requirements will be shared during the initial steps of the recruitment process.

Can I apply to more than one role?

While you are not limited by the number of applications, we strongly recommend investing your time, passion, and energy in applying to positions that align with your experience to give yourself the best chance of success.

What is the offered length of the internship?

We offer 4-month work terms with a possibility of extension to 8-months.
