

Canadian Navigable Waters Act

Seaspan Ferries Corporation (Seaspan) hereby gives notice that a

submission has been added to the Common Project Search (online registry) pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* described herein and its description.

Pursuant to paragraph 4.1 and 9.1 of the said Act,

Seaspan has deposited with the Minister of Transport,

on the on-line Common Project Search Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>) and

under registry number #4025, a description of the following work:

Exploratory site investigation geotechnical drilling at three locations within the Water Lot (title number #CA1907766) which is owned by Seaspan. The offshore work will include core penetration test (CPT) and split-spoon sampling techniques. All investigations shall be to a maximum depth below river-bottom of 45m. All equipment will be positioned on a temporary anchored barge, within the project footprint of the Water Lot, outside of the navigation channel boundaries. The work will take place

in the South Arm of the Fraser River

at Berth 5, Tilbury Island, Delta, B.C
